 - Extra Quality Points (EQPs) are only added to the overall the weighted GPA includes the following EQPs.
 - Pre-IB, Magnet and Honors level courses earn 0.5 EQPs
 - AB/IP & World Languages levels IV-V earn 1.0 EQPs
 - The unweighted GPA is cumulative without the EQPs.
