- Our Grade Point Average (GPA) is computed on a 4.0 scale.
  - Only includes classes taken in 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades.
  - Middle school classes earn credit, but do NOT calculate into the student's high school GPA.
- Numeric grades on the transcript are actual grades the student has earned.
  - Extra Quality Points (EQPs) are only added to the overall weighted GPA and includes the following EQPs:
    - Pre-IB, Magnet and Honors level courses earn 0.5 EQPs
    - AB/IP & World Languages levels IV-V earn 1.0 EQPs
  - The unweighted GPA is cumulative without EQPs.
